Annual conet Donation 2026: More Than €25,000 for International Humanitarian Aid

The conet Social Club brings together the commitment of employees and management in support of Médecins Sans Frontières, UNICEF and Welthungerhilfe

Bonn, February 18, 2026. With an annual donation totaling **€25,320**, the conet Group is supporting the international aid organizations **Médecins Sans Frontières, UNICEF, and Deutsche Welthungerhilfe**. As in previous years, the fundraising campaigns once again focused on togetherness: The donation is the **result of numerous fundraising actions** coordinated by the conet Social Club over the past year and in the run-up to Christmas, which were initiated by employees, trainees, and management.

The **conet Social Club** brings together social initiatives within the group of companies. The aim is to make social responsibility tangible and to actively involve employees in the selection and implementation of donation projects. This year, the focus is deliberately looking beyond regional boundaries. After the employees nominated recipient organizations, a **company-wide vote** decided **how the donations would be distributed**. According to the distribution key from the vote, **Médecins Sans Frontières will receive €12,498, UNICEF €6,005, and Deutsche Welthungerhilfe €6,817**. All three organizations do important humanitarian work worldwide – from emergency medical aid in crisis and war zones to protecting children and fighting hunger and malnutrition. Starting yesterday and in the coming days, the individual donations will be handed over to the recipient organizations at the conet locations in Bonn and Berlin. Due to the company's different fiscal year, the conet Group's central donation campaign traditionally takes place in the last weeks of the current fiscal year, which will end on March 31.

conet CEO Martin Wibbe says: "Unfortunately, global crises and wars are once again more acute and more present than ever. And even though the **willingness to donate in Germany** remains at a gratifyingly high level despite economic challenges, there is still an immense need for funds in the daily aid work locally, regionally, and internationally. We want **to take responsibility as a company** and the fact that the majority of the fundraising campaigns, the nomination of the organizations, and the distribution of donations were carried out by our **employees** underscores that community engagement is an important part of our corporate culture. It is a valuable and visible sign of what is possible when we act together as a community and society."
